Operation Orders No. 23.

In the Field, May 7th, 1916.

Ref. Map Sheet 28. France & Belgium, 1/40,000.

- The Battalion will parade by platoons on Sunday, May 7th, at an hour to be named later, for movement to Camp "A" to go into Divisional Beserve.
- 2. Order of March.

 Scouts, Signallers, Bombers, Machine-Gun Section, Head-quarters Staff, followed by Companies A,B,C, and D, each unit and platoon to be one hundred yards apart.
- 3. Route. From Camp to CROSS ROADS at H.13.b.9 1/2.2, thence CROSS ROADS H.7.c.3.5, thence to ROAD JUNCTION G.18.5.9. to Camp "A", G.11.C.
- 4. Dress. Heavy Marching order, overcoats to be worn, blankets and ground-sheets to be carried in pack. All baggage to be ready for Transport by 2.00 P.M.
- 5. Lewis-Guns. One Lewis-Gun Crew will remain in post until last platoon is marched out, when they will follow. Packs of these three men to be carried on Transport along with Gun-Box.
- 6. Camp must be left clean and, if necessary, for this purpose, a rear party will be left to clean up after Battalion is marched off.
