Originally enlisted with the 135th Battalion, Wygold joined the 60th Battalion on December 6, 1916 as part of a reinforcing draft from the 125th Battalion. He was transferred to the 87th on breakup of the 60th Battalion April 23, 1917.

He went missing in action on the 15th of August 1917. He was later report to have been wounded in the leg and Right upper arm and a Prisoner of War held at Feldaz, Oignes France. He was later reported to have died of his wounds on August 23, 1917. Edward Wygold was buried in the Oignes Communal Cemetery – Germans Extension. His body was exhumed and reburied in the Cabaret Rouge British Cemetery on November 27, 1923.
